Goal 1: Health

#1 choice: Children and youth receive regular, preventive health care

#2 choice: The percentage of youth pursuing risky behaviors is decreasing (distant second choice)

Goal 2: Safety

#1 choice: The incidence of domestic/child abuse & neglect is decreasing

#2 choice: Children and youth report an increasing sense of neighborhood safety (distant second choice)

Goal 3: Education

#1 choice: Children enter kindergarten ready to learn

#2 choice: Elementary grade students are prepared to succeed in later grades (distant second choice)

Goal 4: Stability

#1 choice: Children and youth report positive values and identity

#2 choice: Families are positively connected through mutual support networks (close second choice)
